#### The Bible Teaches that Abortion is Evil...

Dr. Terry Johnson, reformationtoday.com (abridged)

- 1. By teaching that all human life is sacred. This is clearly the meaning of the 6th Commandment, the prohibition of murder (Ex. 20:13). Human life, unlike insect or animal life, may not be wrongfully destroyed. Why? Because it alone is in the "image" of God, and therefore sacred. Because man is made in God's image, the wrongful taking of human life requires the ultimate penalty. All human life is in the image of God, and therefore sacred.
- 2. By teaching that unborn life is human life. Among the many texts to which we could look two stand out.

  Psalm 139:13 "For Thou didst form my inward parts;
  Thou didst weave me in my mother's womb."

Psalm 51:5 (NIV) "Surely I have been...sinful from the time my mother conceived me."

3. By providing legal protection for the unborn. Even if one were still not convinced that the Bible teaches full humanity and sanctity of unborn human life it is undeniable that it does extend legal protection to life within the womb. Exodus 21:22-25 envisions a situation in which two men are struggling and accidentally strike a pregnant woman. What is impressive about this is that it is defined as accidental and, normally, an accidental killing would not have resulted in the forfeiture of one's life (e.g. Ex 21:13,14). But here, even the accidental harming of a pregnant woman brings the provisions of the lex talionis to bear: "life for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, burn for burn, wound for wound, bruise for bruise" (Ex 21:23-25).

Thus the Scripture is placing a strong wall of legal protection around the pregnant woman. An extraordinary value is being placed upon her life and, as a consequence, the child developing within her.


